#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Decorate your capiz shells using paints in a design of your choice. Allow to dry before stringing. You can also decorate the coconut shell if you wish.
- 2. Measure and cut 12" pieces of the clear cord (everyone will need 3 pieces). Tie one end onto the coconut shell. Insert the thread through the hole in the capiz shell twice so that the shell does not slide down the thread. Repeat until 4 shells are on each string, spaced evenly apart. Tie off the last shell.

**TIP:** You may want to place glue onto the knots to prevent slipping.

3. Measure and cut a 10" thread to hang from the center of the shell. Knot to secure.
