colored labels. You will also need a small glass jar in which to melt the ingredients, a small saucepan, metal measuring spoons, paper towels, a thin-tipped pen or marker for marking the labels, and lipstick The kit includes 4 one-dram bottles of LorAnn Gourmet Flavoring Oil, beeswax, 1 four-ounce bottle of sweet almond oil, 1 four-ounce jar of shea butter, 6 stir sticks, 12 plastic tubes, 12 plastic pots, and 24 for tinting (optional).

Creating Lip Balm

the containers. Place a rectangular label along the barrel of a tube and a round label on the lid of a pot. Lip Balm is simple to make. The beeswax, shea butter and almond oil are melted together in a pot, and flavoring oils are added. It is easiest to make the lip balm in batches. Each batch will fill 4 containers. The lip balm takes about 10 minutes to make, and 20 minutes to harden. Labels have been included for the tubes and pots. Use a thin-tipped pen or marker to write on the labels before attaching them to

- Before you begin, hand wash a small glass jar with a lid, along with the plastic tubes and pots and dry them thoroughly.
- N .-Fill a shallow pot (a small saucepan works well) with 1 inch of water, and bring to a boil. Lower heat to medium. Combine 4 teaspoons beeswax, 2 teaspoons shea butter and 3 teaspoons almond oil in small glass jar (for a glossier lip balm, add an extra 1 1/2 teaspoons of almond oil), set the glass jar into the pot, the water should be below the rim of the jar. Stir the mixture using a wooden stir stick until all of the wax and plant butter has melted.
- Remove the jar from the pot and add 1/4 teaspoon of LorAnn Gourmet Flavoring Oil. Close jar with Ild and shake vigorously to combine
- W 4 N holes that may occur in the center of the lip balm. To tint your lip balm, add lipstick shavings to the jar and stir to combine, adding more lipstick until desired color is achieved (see Adding Colors on the back of this sheet).

 Carefully pour the melted lip balm into your tubes and pots (use caution as lip balm is hot). Fill each container to the rim. An additional drop of lip balm can be added to the containers to prevent settling
- 9 glass jar with soap and water. Jar may be re-used for other batches Allow the lip balm to harden without disturbing for 20 minutes. Discard stir sticks. Use a paper towel to wipe excess lip balm from the glass jar while it is still melted, then wipe clean. Hand wash the

Adding Colors

Tinted lip balm makes a delightful gift. You can use lipsticks in any shade, even blue and green to color your lip balm. Inexpensive lipsticks work very well. To use, shave off a bit of lipstick with a knife and add to the melted lip balm. Start with a small amount and add more color until desired tone is achieved.

Mixing Flavors

- 1/8 teaspoon peppermint + 1/8 teaspoon tangerine
- 1/8 teaspoon tangerine + 1/8 teaspoon pineapple
